²DPT Program matriculation requires successful completion of all program prerequisites and undergraduate course requirements.

³PT 621 in the Fall and PT 622 in the Spring (9 credits) will fulfill the remaining Psychology requirements, including the 3rd Psychology elective, PS 335 and the Psychology internship (PS 396). These 9 credits and grades of PT course work will be applied to the undergraduate degree in Psychology.
