

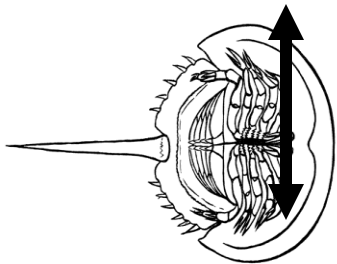
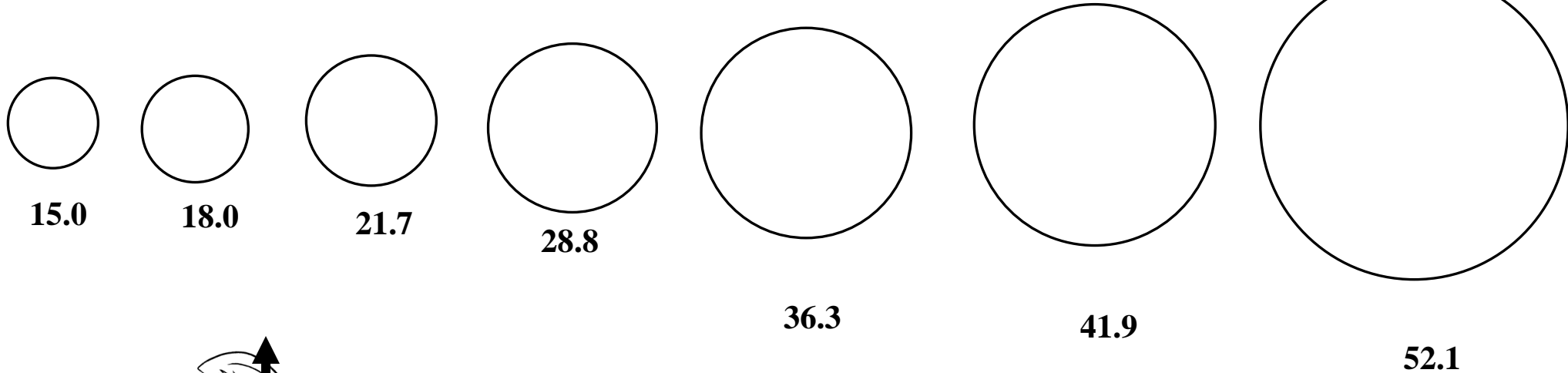
# Juvenile Horseshoe Crab Sizing Guide



Juvenile HSC leave a distinct wide “trail” that can be distinguished from the small “trails” mud snails produce.



If any juveniles found are larger than the largest circle on this guide please measure the carapace width in mm using a ruler. Gently turn the juvenile over onto its back and measure the widest part of the prosoma. All measurements are given in mm.



The arrow in this dorsal view shows where to measure prosoma width of a juvenile horseshoe crab (in millimeters, mm).
