Transfer Credit: Credit is awarded from regionally accredited colleges and universities offerings. SHU reserves the right to examine selected courses to determine whether for courses that carry grades of C or better and that parallel Sacred Heart University (SHU) or not their content and quality fit the University's purpose and goals. SHU will accept a maximum of 66 credits from 2-year schools and 90 credits from 4-year institutions. For those students who come in with at least 60 credits from a regionally accredited 2-or 4-year institution, the standard SHU Core Curriculum will be waived. However, in order to eam a Bachelor's degree from Sacred Heart University, students will need (1) CIT 202 and (2) at least 40 credits (including transfer credits) in general education: humanities, social/behavioral sciences, math, natural sciences, and/or computer science. Students should review their major checksheet and degree evaluations after transfer credits are posted to their SHU transcript.
