All students will complete the University core curriculum (45 credits)

Students will complete a 36-credit emphasis in one of the following four areas:

Humanities and Arts; Natural Sciences; Social Sciences; and Business Studies; 12 of these credits must be at the 200-level or higher. Please note that a minimum grade of C is required for each class in the 36-credit emphasis. Also, please note that courses from the Foundational Core may count in one's 36-credit emphasis, contingent upon the department chairs' approval.

Humanities and Arts:

Art & Design; Communications; History; Media Arts; Languages and Literatures;
Music; Philosophy; Religious Studies; and, Theatre Arts.

Natural Sciences:

Biology; Chemistry; Computer Science; Exercise Science; Health Science; Mathematics, Nursing; and, Physics.

Social Sciences:

Anthropology; Criminal Justice; Economics; Global Studies; Political Science; Psychology; Social Work; and, Sociology.

Business Studies:

Accounting; Economics; Finance; Marketing; Management; Sport Management.
