Housed in The School of Communication, Media & the Arts, the Theatre Arts major is a multidisciplinary program that prepares students to enter the theatre industry or acting profession by gaining the requisite knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to pursue the most competitive jobs and career paths in theatre and related performing arts. Through a curriculum that combines theory and practice, Theatre Arts majors will acquire leadership skills through collaborative learning that focuses on artistic integrity, intellectual inquiry, and development of the professional values and skills that lend themselves to a successful career. Theatre Arts majors have the choice of two concentrations: Acting and Musical Theatre. Students concentrating in Acting are required to take courses on acting, playwriting, and directing; while those concentrating in Musical Theatre will take classes focusing on acting, voice and dance.
