Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement) & Initial and Subsequent Counseling

Complete the online Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement), TEACH Counseling, and complete the information below. Please note: When you sign the Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement), you agree:

- to serve as a full-time, highly qualified teacher for at least four elementary or secondary school years within eight years of completing, or otherwise ceasing to be enrolled in, the program for which you received the TEACH Grant.
- to teach in a low-income school.
- to teach in a high-need field in the majority of classes that you teach during the school year.
- to confirm with your TEACH Grant servicer in writing within 120 days after you have completed or ceased to be enrolled in a program for which you received a TEACH Grant that you are either employed as a full-time teacher following the terms and conditions of the Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement), or that you are not yet employed, but intend to meet the terms and conditions of the Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement).
- to annually certify your teaching service with your TEACH Grant servicer as described in the Agreement to Serve or Repay (Agreement).
